

Fire Kills!

On Tuesday night or early Wednesday morning (24th-25th July) fires were started deliberately in Sparkford Copse, around the edge of the parking area above the railway bridge. A large pile of leaves and garden waste which had been fly-tipped there recently was set on fire, with extra wood added, and another fire was started at the base of a tree. A Sparkford Copse Trust metal sign was also vandalised.

The Castle Cary Fire Brigade was called and was able to stop the fire from spreading deeper into the copse through the very dry undergrowth. Both arson attacks and the criminal damage have been reported to the Police.
