Temporary Closure of Sutton Montis Road

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Sutton Montis Road - from the junction with Marston Road, eastwards for a total distance of 141 metres.

This Order will enable **BT Openreach to carry out underground cabling works.**

The Order becomes effective on 21st July 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **28th July 2022** and last until **4th August 2022** between the hours of **21:00 - 06:00** for a total of **7 nights excluding the weekend.**
